

Term 3 Plan for Year Three and Four January 2017

Geography and History

The children will:

- Locate where Egypt is on a map and learn about the river Nile.
- Learn about the Ancient Egyptians and how they have influenced us today.
- Learn about the role of archaeologists

Maths

The children will:

- Recall multiplication and division facts of the multiplication tables up to 12 X 12.
- Add and subtract numbers mentally.
- Measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths; mass; volume/capacity
- Recognise and write decimals equivalents to some simple fractions and tenths and hundredths (year 4)
- Identify, estimate and represent different numbers.
- Tell the time to the nearest minute.
- Read, write and convert time to analogue to digital clock.

English

Treasure Island:

- Plan, write and edit a story with at least 5 chapters.
- Describe and create settings, characters and plots.
- Compose a rehearse their story orally.
- Use a range of conjunctions and adverbs in their writing.
- Use and punctuate direct speech.

Art and Design

Art- To improve their mastery of art techniques including drawing and painting with a range of materials.
