



Dear Parents,

Here are just a few 'housekeeping' things and updates Mrs G and I would like to share with you:

### 1. **Planners:**

Planners are a very useful tool for us to use in school, and can be a line of communication between Mrs G and I, and you as parents. Please could you check your child/ren's planner once a week and sign it to acknowledge that you have checked the contents of the planner. Also, feel free to write any notes for things that we at school need to be aware of. We will generally write a reply in the planner, so it would be useful if you could sign the comment so that we know it has been seen.

Planners are checked on Monday mornings. If there has been anything else added to the planner during the week that we need to be made aware of, please could your child hand the planner back to Mrs G or I. Thank you!

### 2. **Equipment:**

**Pens/pencils:** Please could the children have handwriting, friction or fountain pens rather than biros? Biros have been banned school wide and they do make writing rather messy. This also applies to work completed in homework books. Smiggle is becoming more and more popular throughout school, particularly in Class 3. Whilst I appreciate that items from Smiggle cost considerable amounts of money, they are starting to become a little bit of a distraction for all in Class 3. I would ask that these items are kept to a minimum.

### **PE Kit**

PE kit needs to be in school throughout the week so that they are available at all times. PE in Class 3 is taught on Wednesday and Friday afternoons, however it could be and is needed throughout the week. **Please make sure all of the kit the children bring in is named so that any lost items can be found and returned to the rightful owner.**

### 3. **Homework:**

Homework is set half termly in advance, and the list of homework can be found in your child's homework books. The children are asked to complete one of the tasks set in their books a week, and these are to be handed in on Thursday mornings. Additionally, the children will also be set a list of spellings where they need to re-write each spelling, put the spelling into a sentence and then define each spelling word. These spelling are tested on a **Friday morning**. We also test times tables and mental arithmetic on a Friday morning.
