Children are given opportunities for role play and 'conscience alley' activities which enable them to explore their own views and moral values with the support and guidance of the class teacher.</p>	<p>Pair sharing, class discussion and small group work promote good listening and speaking skills.</p> <p>Children are presented with different situations for discussion and have the opportunity to reflect on their own and others' contributions.</p>	<p>PSHE enables children to look at similarities and differences between their own and others' cultures. They are introduced to key concepts related to British culture and values, such as democracy and the rule of law, which is covered in a sensitive and age-appropriate way within the PSHE curriculum.</p>
