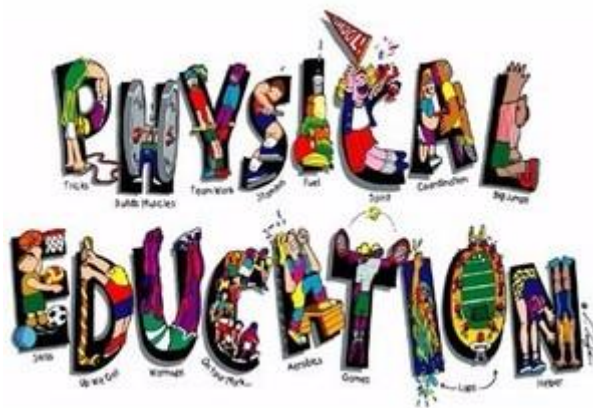

Sports premium is used towards a variety of PE and sporting activities. Ashton Park Sports partnership provide us with a programme of sports competitions with other schools, training for teachers, networking and taster days for children to try out new skills. We also compete in the Bristol Schools Netball League and we were the league winners this year.

We have taken part in a range of events involving children across the school including: Netball, Tag Rugby, Tri- Golf, 'Stages' dance, Gymnastics, Football, Cycling, Swimming, Playground Leader training, crown green bowling, hockey, cross country running

There are also a range of clubs after school: Football KS1/2; Netball Y3/4 and Y5/6; Tag Rugby KS2; Dance Reception/KS1/2.

Four boys have signed contracts with a Football/Learning Academy, which provides training but also sets targets with teachers for learning in school.

Cycling starts in Reception with balance bikes and progresses through the school to KS2. Free wheel Fridays are organised for children to bring their own scooters and roller boots to school to complete laps around a course.

We view Physical Education and sports participation as an essential part of our Healthy Schools agenda in all key stages together with use of our playground climbing equipment and visits to Forest School in developing a variety of skills, strength, coordination, independence and resilience.

Pupil premium is also used for eligible children to encourage participation in clubs and activities.
