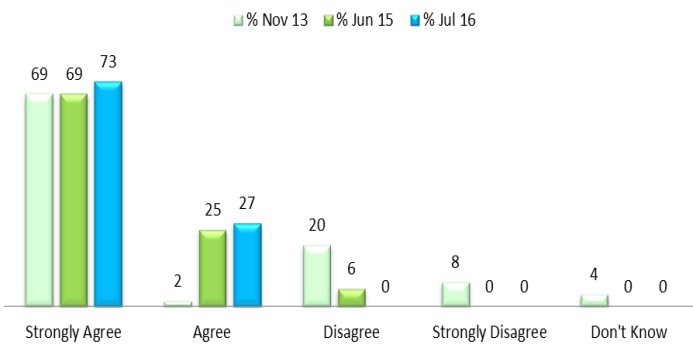
## Overview

## Parent View Survey - Results



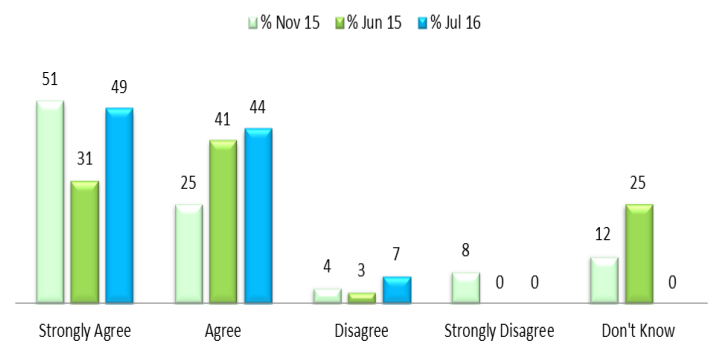
### This school ensures the pupils are well behaved

- Focus on positive praise and records of sanctions, Golden Time and rewards now all logged in contact books.

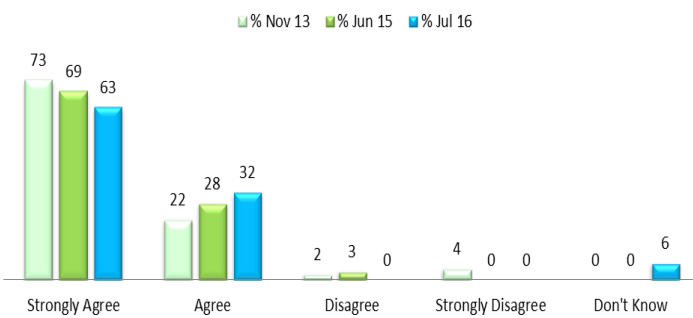
### This school deals effectively with bullying

- Focus on positive praise and records of sanctions, Golden Time and rewards now all logged in contact books.

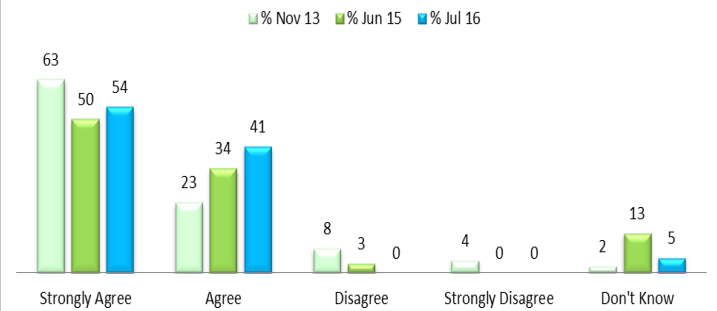
### This school is well led and managed

- Continue with annual Parent View survey to be conducted each Summer Term to receive parents' feedback on the school.

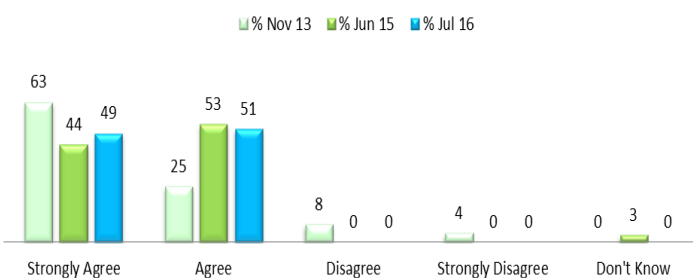
### This school responds well to any concern I raise

- All concerns / issues continue to be logged and monitored by headteacher.

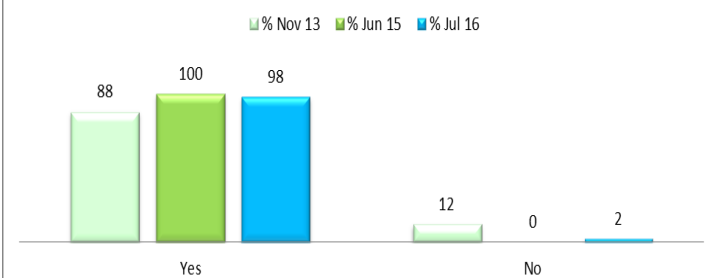
### I receive valuable information about my child's progress
