We have continued our flight around the world and we have discovered the 7 continents and 5 oceans of planet Earth. We have really enjoyed this song on youtube:

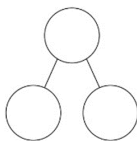
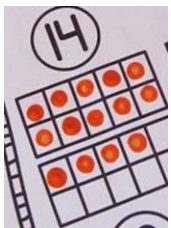
