	<p>"we could have cctv to observe the driving"</p> <p>"we do have cctv outside the school so I don't think we need this"</p> <p>"I am really angry that the council don't want to spend money. You have to spend money - otherwise sometimes it can cost something else."</p> <p>"Are we waiting for a fatal accident?"</p> <p>"If a child got hit, it will either be 3 faults, the child, the driver or the council because they have ignored our ideas. "</p> <p>For our fetes, twice a year we could request closing the road for safety as it is a special event.</p> <p>DS to email Miranda back thanking her for the response. Say the children are disappointed with the response because they are very concerned for safety.
