- I must be polite and sensible to everybody when I am using the internet.
- I must not break these rules, if I do then my teacher will not let me use the internet and my parents will be told about it.

Key Stage 2 Pupil's Acceptable Use Policy

These rules help us to be fair to others and keep everyone safe.

- I will only use ICT in school for school purposes.
- I will only use my own network login and password.
- I understand that I must never tell other people my ICT passwords.
- I will only open or delete my own files.
- I understand that I must not bring software or disks into school without permission.
- I will ask for permission before using the Internet and will not use internet chat.
- If I see anything I am unhappy with I will turn the monitor off and tell a teacher immediately.
- I understand that I must never give out my own details online such as my name, email, phone number or home address. I will not arrange to meet someone unless this is part of a school project approved by my teacher and a responsible adult comes with me.
- I will only use my school email address for school work whether I access my email from school or outside school.
- I will only e-mail people I know from school, or who my teacher has approved.
- I will only open email attachments from people I know from school, or whom my teacher has approved.
- If I receive messages I do not like, I will tell a teacher immediately.
- I will make sure that all online contact with other children and adults is responsible, polite and sensible.
- I will support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any photographs, images, videos, sounds or text that could upset anyone.
- I understand that if I deliberately break these rules, I may not be allowed to use the internet or computers.
- I understand that my use of ICT can be checked and that my parent/ carer contacted if a member of school staff is concerned about my E-Safety.

The school may exercise its right to monitor the use of the school's computer systems, including access to web-sites, the interception of e-mail and the deletion of inappropriate materials where it believes unauthorised use of the school's computer system is or may be taking place, or the system is or may be being used for criminal purposes or for storing unauthorised or unlawful text, imagery or sound. Parents / Guardians will be contacted if a member of school staff is concerned about E-Safety. Failure to work to these rules could result in a child not being allowed to use the internet or computers.
