We have been informed that last November's Poppy Collection raised £350.19. A well deserving Charity. Thank you all who contributed.

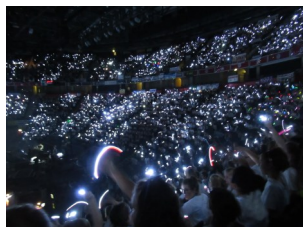


Dalton School hosted a Sainsbury's School Games Boccia Tournament. 5 schools took part (60 children in total) and Dalton School were the winners!!!

Young Voices

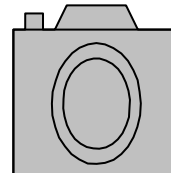
