

Performance Data 2015-2016

Assessment in primary schools was reformed in 2016 and a new expected standard has been created, which reflects a higher standard than in 2015. Results are no longer reported as levels: each child receives their test results as a scaled score from 80 - 120 and teacher assessments based on the standards in the new framework. A high score is 110 or above.

The Grange Primary School standards for 2016 are listed below with the national average being given in brackets.

KS2

The percentage of children achieving **the expected level** or above in **reading, writing and maths: 35% (53%)**
