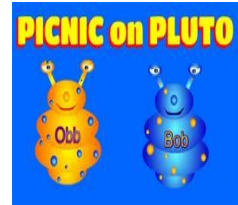
Year 1 spelling focus:

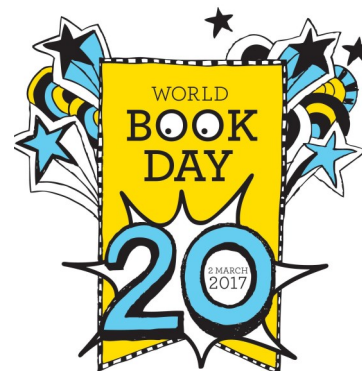
Tuesday 21st February
