Red Nose Day

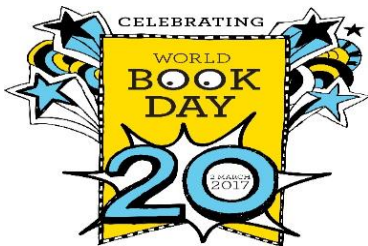
It is red nose day on Friday 24th March. Please wear red for a small donation to Comic Relief.
