INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOL

1. The name of the school is Our Lady and All Saints Catholic Primary School
2. The school was founded by and is part of the Catholic Church. The school is to be conducted as a Catholic School in accordance with the canon law and teachings of the Catholic Church and in accordance with the Trust Deed of the Ampleforth Abbey Trust in particular:
 - (a) religious education is to be in accordance with the doctrines, discipline and general and particular norms of the Catholic Church;
 - (b) religious worship is to be in accordance with the liturgical norms of the Catholic Church;

and at all times the school is to serve as a witness to the Catholic faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ.

3. The School is a voluntary aided school in the trusteeship of the Ampleforth Abbey Trust which is a registered Charity. The objects of Ampleforth Abbey Trust include:
 - (a) The education of children, young persons and mature students, in accordance with the doctrines and principles of the Roman Catholic faith;
 - (b) Such other charitable purposes in connection with the advancement of education which is in accordance with the general aims of the Ampleforth Abbey Trust and of the Roman Catholic faith as the Directors think fit from time to time.
4. The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body of Our Lady and All Saints Catholic Primary School"
5. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) 2 parent governors
 - (b) 1 local authority governor
 - (c) 1 staff governor

(d) 1 headteacher

(e) 7 foundation governors

6. The total number of governors is: 12
7. Foundation governors shall be appointed and may be removed by the Abbot of Ampleforth (or any other person exercising Ordinary jurisdiction on his behalf).
8. This instrument of government comes into effect on 14 July 2015
9. This instrument was made by order of Lancashire local authority on 13 July 2015
10. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body, (and the headteacher if not a governor), the Ampleforth Abbey Trustees and the Archdiocese of Liverpool.
