

## **The Wey House Vision, Values and Ethos**

### **About us**

Wey House is a Community Special School and Surrey County Council educational provision for primary phase children with registered Education, Health and Care Plans for Social, Emotional and Mental Health difficulties. Some children also have associated learning difficulties which have impacted on their ability to access the curriculum in mainstream schools. All referrals and placements at the school are through the local authority. We are currently registered for 36 pupils and have 55 on roll. There are ongoing discussions with the local authority to increase our PAN and negotiate places with neighbouring authorities.

### **Our vision, values and purpose**

Wey House recognises that we are an essential element of Surrey County Council's early intervention SEN strategy that provides support for children with SEMH and EHCP's in the county. We believe that our intervention can make a significant difference in the future of our children's lives and impact positively on their families and the local community. Our new vision and direction is to become an outward looking school that supports the needs of the county and surrounding authorities' SEMH clients.

Our primary goal is to sensitively manage the integration of children, who are often in crisis, into our school, welcome them into our boundaried and therapeutic environment; assess their academic, social and emotional needs, provide interventions to develop self-regulation and bridge the gaps in their learning. We aim to provide them with the necessary platform to transition into their carefully chosen secondary educational placements and enhance their life chances in the future.

Wey House staff specialise in creating personalised programmes for every child. Our local offer is constantly evolving through a

whole school focus on CPD and intervention to meet the complex needs of our school community.

The current golden rules are considered out dated and are being redeveloped. A recent review showed that the boys felt 'points' should be more weighted towards work, hence they will be changed in the new academic year to place a greater focus on learning. Interim measures have been put in operation that place a greater emphasis and reward value on the 'We work hard' element until the new expectations are launched with all stakeholders.
