History

Castles: focus on Clitheroe Castle; how castles were built, what they were made from, how they were defended, what life was like in a castle.

ICT

Using Digimaps and Google Earth to locate our school.

Programming Beebots to give directions.

Developing familiarity with a keyboard (space bar, backspace, shift and enter keys)

Changing the size, font and colour of text.

Science

Everyday Materials: Properties of materials and where materials come from. How materials are suited for particular uses.

Animal survival and growth: life cycles, how animals look different to one another, carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

PE

Dance: creating a sequence of movements in response to a stimulus. Link actions fluently and with control and coordination.

Games: Bat and ball games; develop coordination when using bats and balls.

Use simple tactics and strategies.

English

Traditional tales, stories in familiar settings, explanations.

Poems with structure; riddles.

Phonics; continuing to blend and segment words for reading and writing.

Spelling common exception words and using knowledge of phonics to choose correct sound for spelling words, using prefixes and suffixes.

Grammar: Nouns, adjectives and verbs. Identifying each of these types of words in a sentence, using conjunctions, including detail in writing to add interest.

Punctuation: Using commas in lists, exclamation marks and question marks.

Handwriting, forming **all** letters correctly, lower case and capital letters, and numbers correctly. Y2; develop a joined handwriting style.

Maths

Time: days of the week, months of the year, telling the time to the quarter hour. Y2s tell the time to 5 minutes.

Number and place value - knowing the value of a digit. Counting in tens.

Measures: Length and height, mass/weight, and Time. Reading scales. Fractions of amounts.

Money: recognising coins, counting money, giving change, solving problems.

Multiplication and Division: Learning the 2, 5, 10, 3 and 4 times tables and corresponding division facts. Problem solving involving time, measures, money, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Addition & Subtraction linked to measurement. Learning the addition/subtraction facts to 20.

Position and Direction: $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ turns, clockwise and anti-clockwise.

Please support your child by helping them learn the addition and subtraction facts and the times tables (including the division facts).
