

# *The Pilgrim School (a Church of England Primary with Nursery)*

The Pilgrim School is a primary school that requires its pupils to wear a school uniform. As a Christian environment we believe that all pupils should be treated the same and that in all pupils wearing the same uniform contributes to us being able to achieve this.

### **Uniform**

The school uniform consists of:

- a. Grey or black school trousers, grey skirts or pinafores and plain grey, black, white or purple tights and socks.
- b. Plain white polo (preferably with the school logo embroidered on) or school shirts.
- c. Purple gingham summer dress.
- d. Purple sweatshirt embroidered with the school logo.
- e. Footwear should be appropriate to the activity. Trainers should not be worn as school shoes. No open-toed sandals or high heels.
- f. Long hair should be tied back.
- g. PE kit – black shorts, purple polo with logo, black plimsolls. (Dark tracksuits and trainers for outside activities, especially in cold weather.) Black soled trainers cannot be worn in the school hall.

In addition, the following items with school logo are available

- a. A purple/black fleece.
- b. Book bags.
- c. PE bags.
- d. Sun hats and caps.

All of the above are available to order from the school.



In addition could you provide your child with an art/craft overall to protect their clothing during some activities. (An old shirt would suffice.)

Second-hand uniform is available from the reception.

Please make sure that your child's clothing is clearly marked with his or her name. As you will realise, items such as school sweatshirts are almost identical and without a name we have very little chance of identifying garments. Lost property is kept for half a term then disposed of if unclaimed.

### **Jewellery**

If you're thinking about getting your child's ears pierced, it is best to wait until the beginning of the summer holidays. They can then stay in for six weeks. It is only permissible for children to wear either very plain studs or sleeper earrings to school. If your child has pierced ears, then earrings must be removed for PE. Teachers cannot remove earrings. They and The Pilgrim Multi Academy Trust do not accept responsibility for loss or damage to any form of jewellery. Watches may be worn but no other form of jewellery.

Failure to comply with the uniform policy will result in the Headteacher taking appropriate action.
