



## Reading at Rodney House

At Rodney House School the teaching of reading is personalised for the individual.

- For the majority of children this is through the delivery of sensory and patterned stories, that are enhanced to give meaning to the child.
- Children learn rhymes and stories off by heart, through sharing rhythmical stories throughout the school year.
- Phonics at phase one is delivered through music, circle times and 1:1 focus activities
- The teaching of letters and sounds (phase 2 onwards) is through 1:1 and group activities
- Children who are ready to read use a mixed approach of Oxford Reading Tree and Songbird schemes.
- Children are supported to apply their reading knowledge in practical activities including reading recipes.
