



Magellan App User Guide Introduction

Overview

Magellan provides secure local and remote access to all networked and web-based resources through a simple interface. Applications and websites can be accessed simply by clicking or touching the corresponding tile.

My files

You can access your home directory and any shared drives you normally use on the school network from home, or from anywhere with an internet connection. You can also drag and drop files from a local PC to the network and copy or delete your files.

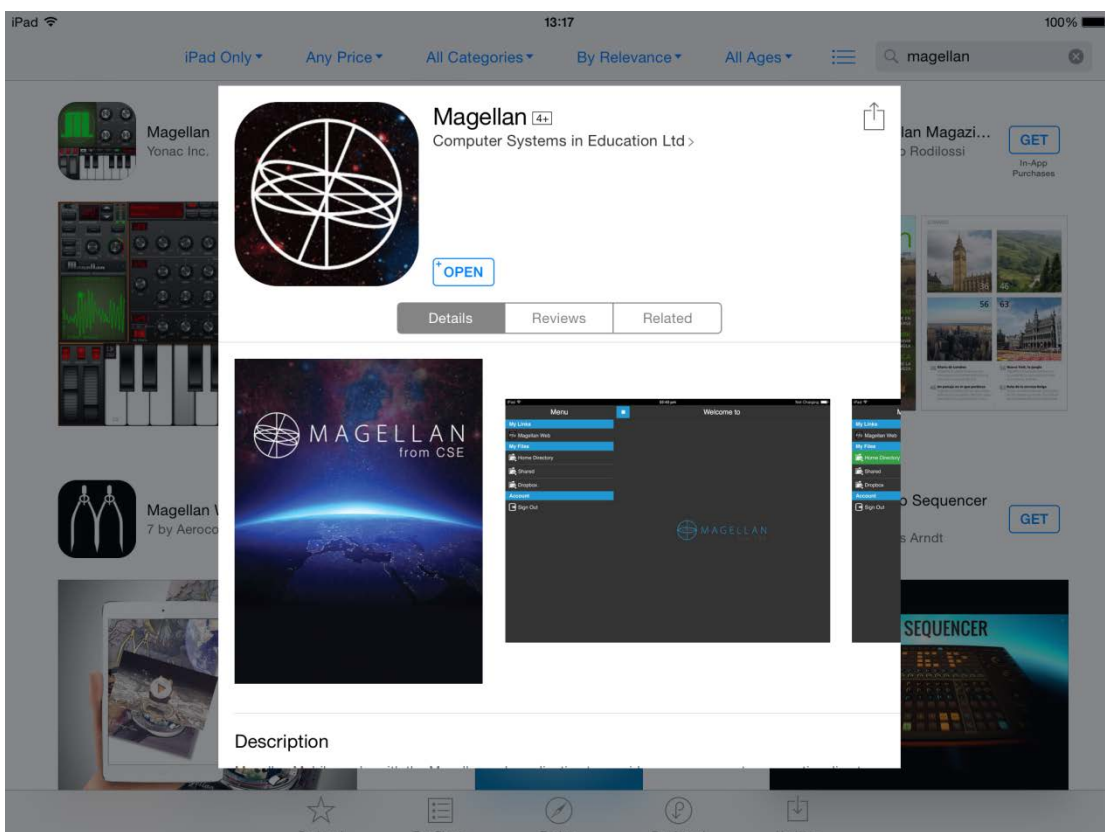
Remote Applications

Remote applications can be run from the tiles in your Magellan. You will see the icons for the specific apps appear in your tiles.

Using the Magellan App

For Apple devices (iPhones, iPads)

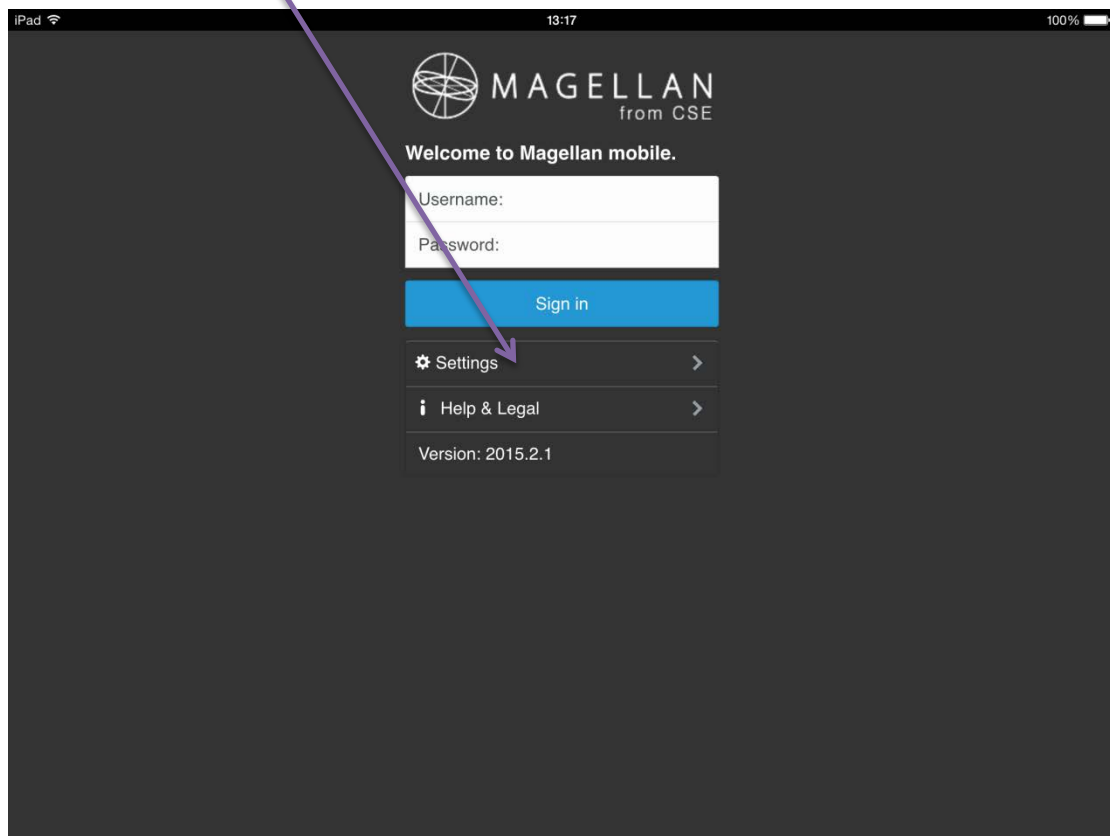
Go to the App Store and type Magellan in the search bar. Select and Install the Magellan App.



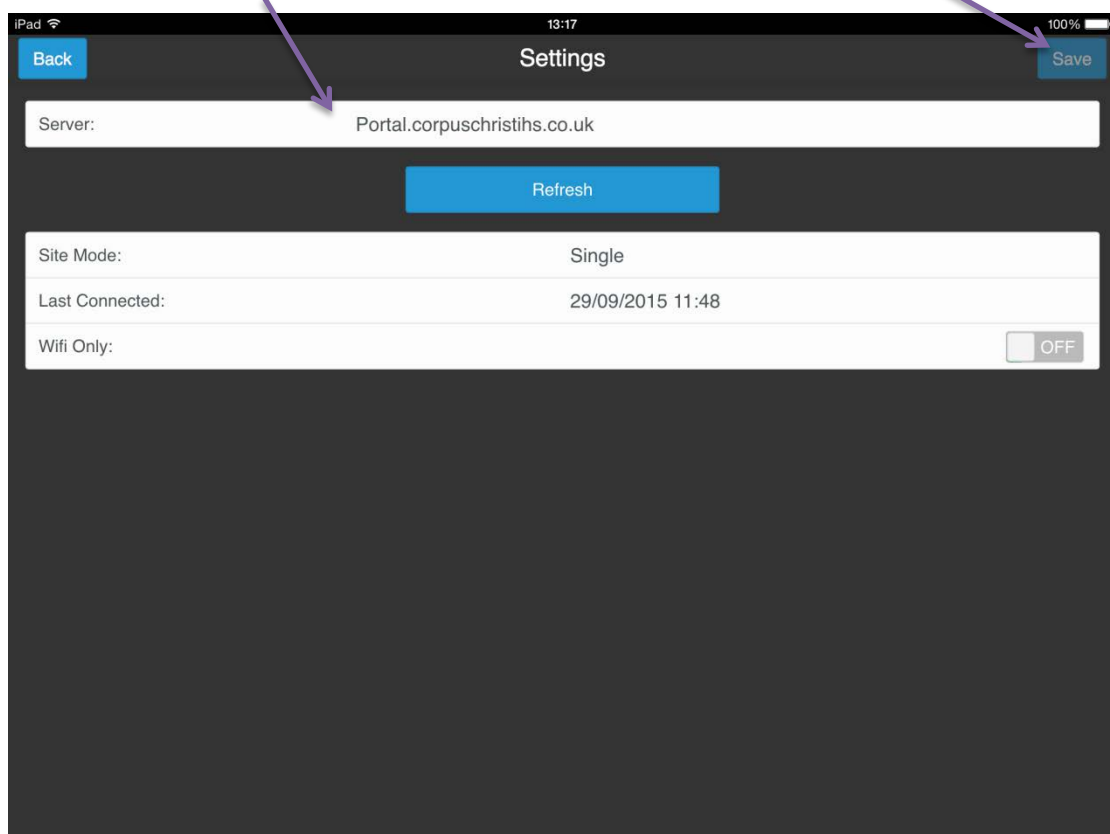


Open the Magellan App. You will see a log in screen but first we have to connect to the Magellan server (you should only have to do this at first time set up).

Select the Settings option



Next, enter **portal.corpuschristihs.co.uk** as the nameserver. Click Save

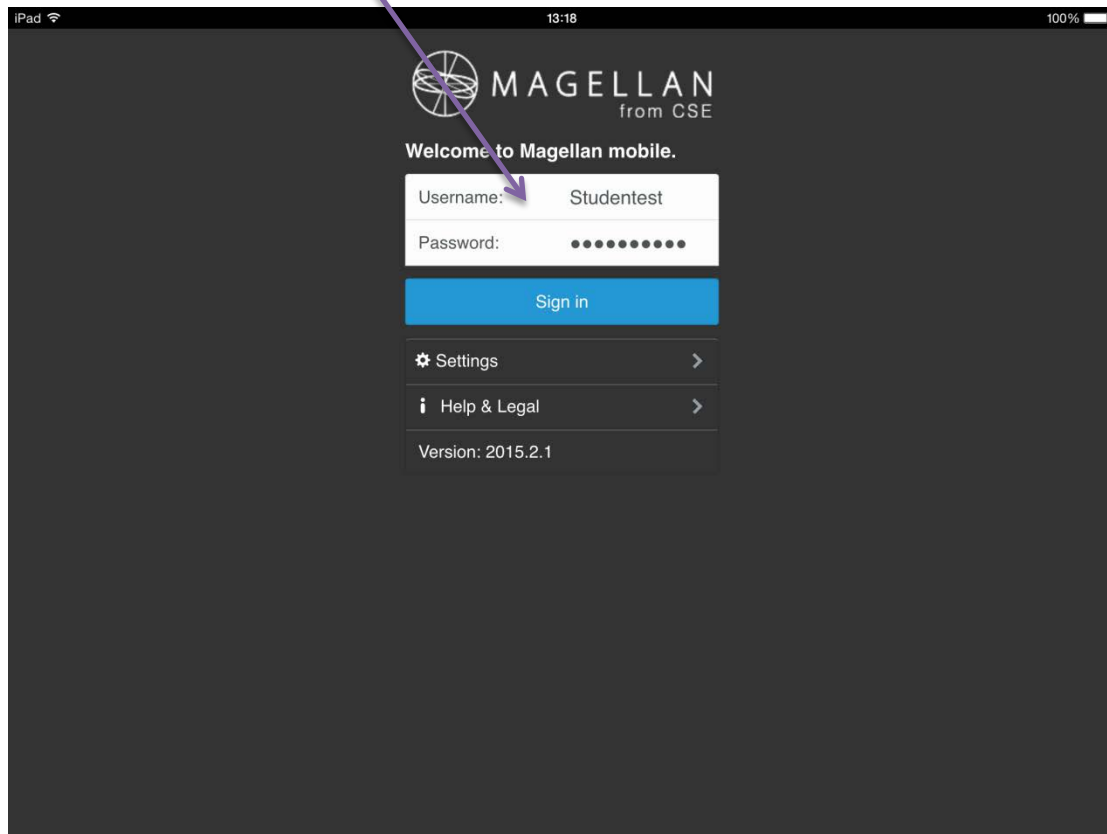




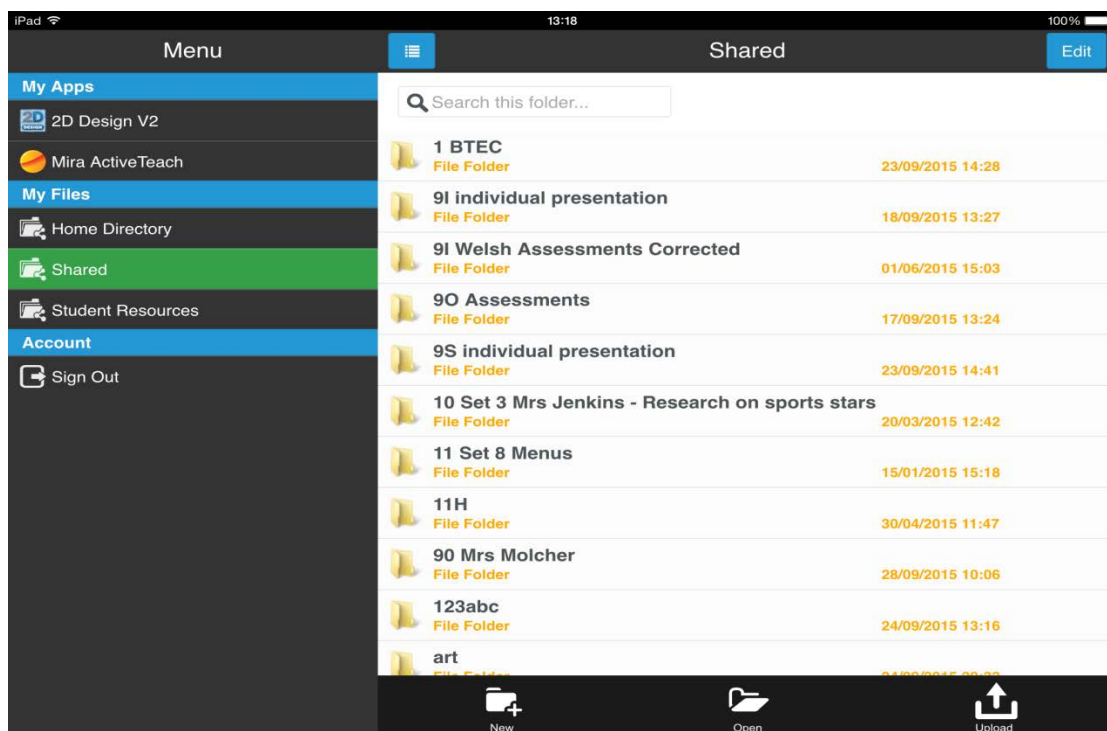
Once you've saved the settings, then click **Back** to the log in page.

You should only have to configure the settings just the once. Next time you use Magellan you just have to sign in using your school credentials.

Enter you school Username and Password and press **Sign In**

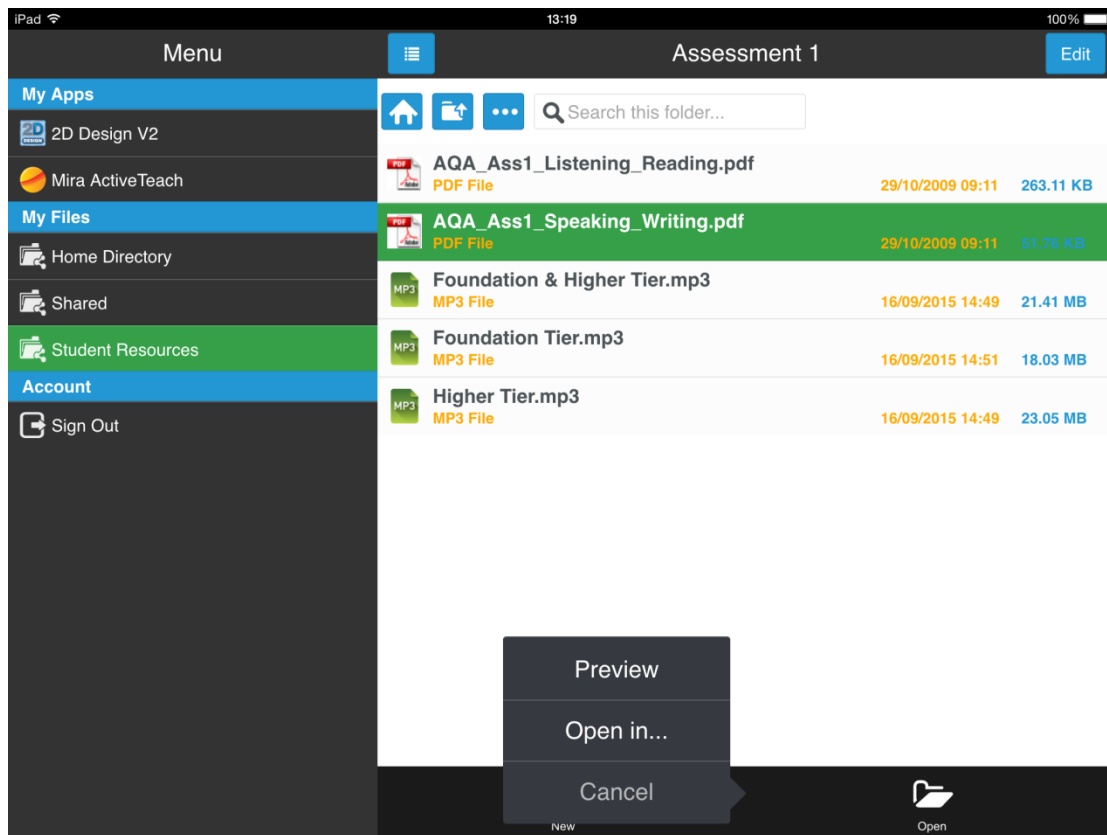


You will now have access to your files, shared documents and school apps.





To open and work on your files, select the file and then Open at the bottom of the App.



Then select Open in... and a pop up box appears with all the available apps that will open up the document. Select Copy to Word (you can install this for free on your iPad using your school Office365 credentials).
