

Performance

The tables below represent the performance of the Year 6, Year 2, Year 1 and Reception children in the national performance tests (SATs etc.) in 2016, 2015 and 2014. The children and their teachers are to be congratulated again this year on both the standards reached and the progress made by everyone. It has been a different challenge because, of course, the children have been tested on the new National Curriculum. It is for this reason that it is very difficult to compare previous years' results with 2016, and the criteria for progress has had to change because the current Year 6 had their attainment measured in levels at the end of Key Stage1 (level1, 2, 3) etc. and now it is measured in marks (points and scaled scores). The system being used to make these assessments is an interim one until 2018 when the cohort of children leaving Year 6 will be the first group of children to go through from Reception to Y6 studying the new National Curriculum.

This year the school has received two letters from The Rt Honorable Nick Gibb, MP, Minister of State for School Standards, congratulating the staff and pupils on the very high standards that were achieved by the Year 1 pupils, 100% of them reached the expected standard in the Year 1 phonics test, and Year 6 for the very high standard of their Mathematics, which placed them in the top 2% of the Country.

Progress score, description and confidence interval

These scores show how much progress pupils at Foxmoor made in reading, writing and maths between the end of Key Stage 1 and the end of Key Stage 2, and compares their results with those of the children **Nationally**, and those of the children in **'Schools like us'**.

The progress scores are calculated **Nationally** by comparing the Key Stage 2 test and assessment results of pupils with their assessment results at the end of the previous Key Stage (K S.1).

The **'Schools like us'** category are schools who got similar assessment results at the end of Key Stage 1, and Foxmoor children's progress is also compared with them.

A score above zero means pupils made more progress, on average, than pupils across England who got similar results at the end of Key Stage 1.

A score below zero means pupils made less progress, on average, than pupils across England who got similar results at the end of Key Stage 1.
