1 Role of the Committee

2 Terms of reference of the committee

To approve policies and practices for the curriculum and the pastoral role of the school, including British values, behaviour and attendance

To evaluate the assessment information on the progress and performance of the school, particularly regarding, attainment and progress from statutory points to being secondary ready.

To monitor the overall quality of learning and teaching in order to give pupils rich, diverse and exciting learning experiences.

To participate in the review and evaluation of the school action plan and SEF.

To monitor the allocation of Pupil Premium and the Sports and PE Grant and evaluate their impact.

3 Level of delegation

Powers of decision making are delegated to the committee.

4 Reporting

The committee's minutes will be circulated by email to governors and also be publicly available on the web site unless confidential. There will be an item on each Governing Body agenda for questions on the latest minutes.

5 Membership

6 governors including the Head and one associate governor. The names of members of the committee are recorded in the Governing Body's minutes.

Committee membership is reviewed at the first meeting of the Governing Body of the academic year and any alterations made at subsequent meetings if required.

6 Quorum

The quorum for meetings shall be 3.
