### **Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> March 9:15- 10**

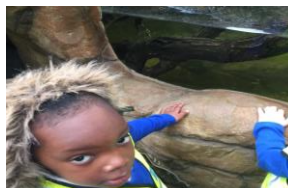
