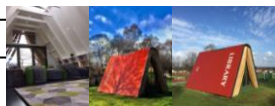

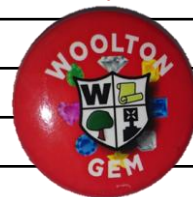


Spanish Day at WPS
