Applications are now invited for Football Club membership up until the end of the school year. The club is open to previous members and new members.

The club is open to any year 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 boys and girls; children do not need to have played before. The training sessions for both the older and younger children will be held on a **Monday**, from 3.30pm to 4.30pm, term 5 and 6 starting Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2017. Year 2 and 3 will have their lesson with one coach, Year 5 and 6 with another. If your Year 4 child is a confident, experienced footballer, they may attend the Year 5/6 session, if not they should attend the Year 2/3 session.

The charge will be **£16** (8 weeks at £2.00 per session) to be paid in advance by cash, cheque or via School Money.

If you are interested in your child attending these sessions, please sign and return the permission slip below. The club is extremely popular so places will be offered on a first come first served basis. **All return slips must go straight to Mrs England in the office.** Children do need to be aware that if they sign up, they are **committed** to coming each week. If your child needs to leave the club during the term please inform the office so places can be given to others.

Please return slips by 4pm on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> April, you will then get a text message to confirm whether or not your child has a place. If you have a place - payment must be made by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May or your child's place will be offered to someone else.

All children need to have shin pads, socks and boots. If it is raining on the day, we will hold the sessions together in the hall. The children will be getting changed into their football kit in the hall at the end of the day. They may leave their belongings in the hall until the end of the session. If your child cannot tie their shoe laces, **please could you send them with Velcro boots or come to the hall at 3.20pm to help them.** If your child is unable to attend a session, please let their class teacher know.
