We wish you all a happy Easter holiday, hoping that the weather remains fine for lots of outside activities.

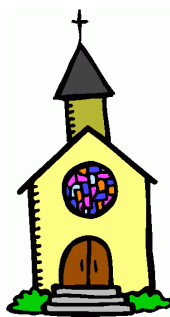
## Foxmoor Flyer
