

Activity	Parent Comment
Looking at different coins 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p	
Coins rubbings	
Coins matching	
Coin swapping e.g. $1p + 1p = 2p$	
Handle money by playing shop, using 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p coins.	
Going to the shops and paying for an item.	

Activity	Parent Comment
Talking about your day using 'before' & 'after'	
Ordering the day	
Singing the days of the week	
Play What's the Time Mr Wolf?	
Go on season walks and discuss the changes.	
How many times in a minute activity e.g. How many socks can you pair up in a minute? How many jumps can you do in a minute?	

Activity	Parent Comment
Ordering toys from smallest to largest.	
Can you find something shorter, longer	
With help measuring quantities to make cakes	
Water play e.g. different containers.	
Planting seeds to see which plant grows the tallest.	
Measuring themselves e.g. weight and height.
