

## Y1 Phonic Check Results - June 2016

Children at the end of Year 1 (aged 5-6) take part in a phonics screening check. This is a statutory assessment for all children in Year 1. It takes place week every June and is administered in school by the Year 1 class teacher. It comprises of a list of 40 words (20 real and 20 nonsense). The expectation from the Government is that pupils should achieve up to 32 out of 40 to reach the expected level.

**The following table compares the percentages by phonics result for the school in 2016 with the national results for 2016.**
