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## **1. Introduction:**

We want to maintain an open relationship with parents/carers and the local community and ensure support and communication channels are clear. We aim to do this by publishing information and policies online. There are some documents which we are under duty to publish online, this document makes clear what information we are required to publish online and other desirable information to be published online.

## **2. Legislative Requirements:**

The School Information (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2012

The Education (Independent School Standards) Regulations 2014

## **3. Information Required Online:**

- The name, postal address and telephone number of the school, and the name of a person to whom enquiries should be addressed  
either:
  - The determined admission arrangements for the school, including any arrangements for selection, any oversubscription criteria and an explanation of the process of applying for a school place, or
  - Information as to where and how parents can access that information in the local authority's composite prospectus published on their website.
- Information as to where and how the most recent Ofsted report about the school and the School Performance Tables can be accessed.
- The school's most recent KS2 results as published by the Secretary of State (for cohorts of 6+ pupils)
- Information about the school's curriculum in relation to each academic year, namely: the content of the curriculum followed by the school for each subject and details as to how additional information relating to the curriculum may be obtained.
- The school's behaviour policy.
- Pupil premium information relating to each academic year, namely: the amount of pupil premium allocation that the school will receive during the academic year; what it intends to spend its pupil premium allocation on; what it spent its pupil premium allocation on in the previous academic year information on a school's website.
- The school's charging and remissions policy.
- A statement of the school's ethos and values.
- The report prepared by the school under Special Educational Needs and Disability Code of Practice.
- SEN policy and accessibility policy.
- Governors information.

#### 4. Desirable Information:

We are not under a statutory duty to publish the following information online but so parents/carers are aware of how the school operates in all aspects. This is a list of things we may publish online, please note that this is not exhaustive:

- Other school policies, including:
  - Sex and Relationship Education
  - Home School agreement
  - How schools are supporting pupils with medical conditions
  - Child Protection policy
- Information about after school clubs and extra-curricular activities.
- School term dates and teacher training dates
- Uniform information.
- Newsletters.
- Gallery of visits to the school, themed days, sports days and classroom activities. Note that we always ask for the parents/carers consent upon admission to the school.
- A downloadable permission slip for school trips.
- FAQ page for parents/carers.
- Parents evening dates.
- School dinner information.
