### **'Money for nothing'**

## **Did you know the BPTA could maximise fundraising with help from you and the companies you work for?**

Dear Parents/Carers

Do you work for a company that offers a match funding scheme? Many companies offer their employees the chance to take part in a matched funding scheme, whereby the company will provide additional funding to a good cause (usually on a £ for £ basis up to a maximum amount).

Generally the employee must have been involved in the fundraising event as a volunteer. For example, a parent volunteers to help on a summer fair stall and the profit made is £500, the parent's employer may then match this amount by a further £500. The amount offered will vary on the organisation and the conditions that may apply.

### **Options for Matched Funding**

Organisations may support the school in a variety of ways including:

- matched funds raised through an activity (i.e. school summer fair)
- a cash donation
- donation of equipment/services (i.e. printing of large documents for the school)
- donation of prizes (suitable for raffles/auctions/tombola)

Many organisations offer a scheme but do not generally advertise this to their staff very well, so you may need to check with your Human Resources department. Please see attached a list of companies that we know potentially offer match funding, however, there may be more. If you know that your company offers a scheme and you would like to help at this year's summer fair please contact a member of the committee.

Last year the BPTA raised over £29,000 which was invested back into equipment and activities to help enrich the learning and enjoyment for all the children. £1,320 of that amount came from one parent whose employer fund matched for the barbeque stall during the summer fair. Just think how much more we could raise if we could tap into these fund matching schemes. Two or three Matched Funders in each year group could make a real difference!
