

Key Stage 2 SATs – Teacher Assessment and Test Results

At Key Stage 2 the children undertook one reading paper, an English punctuation, grammar and spelling test and three maths papers. The children’s marks were converted to a scaled score from 80 to 120. The expected standard was a scaled school of 100.
