Cycling	Estimate £480	For targeted pupils to gain confidence in riding a bike. This has increased skills so the children can access the cycling proficiency in year 5.
Movement Club training	£30.00	Setting up gross and fine motor skills club in school, to work with a small group of children who have co-ordination difficulties.
Lunch time supervisor	£1050.00	Introduction of new games and skills during lunchtime. Focussed activities for all children, increasing confidence and coordination skills. More children are active and involved in organised team games. Fewer incidents at lunch time.
