Parents feel that a reward afternoon would be enjoyable for all winners and that it could also save the school money.	New idea proposed. The prize gets better the more points you have.  Each half term, those who took part would get an extra play time.  KS2 School Councillors are to create a tally as to what the children prefer in their classes.
