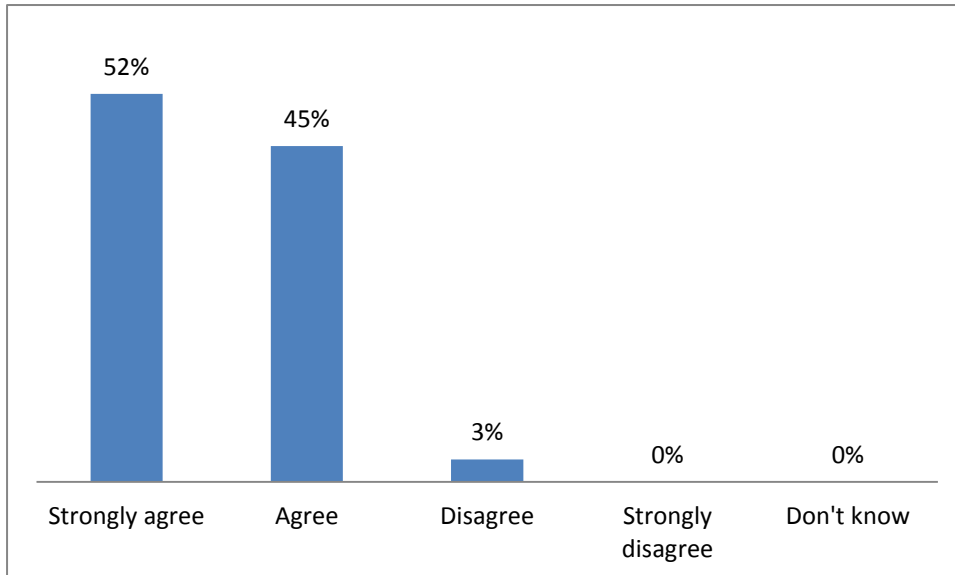


## Mears Ashby C of E Primary School Parent Survey – February 2017

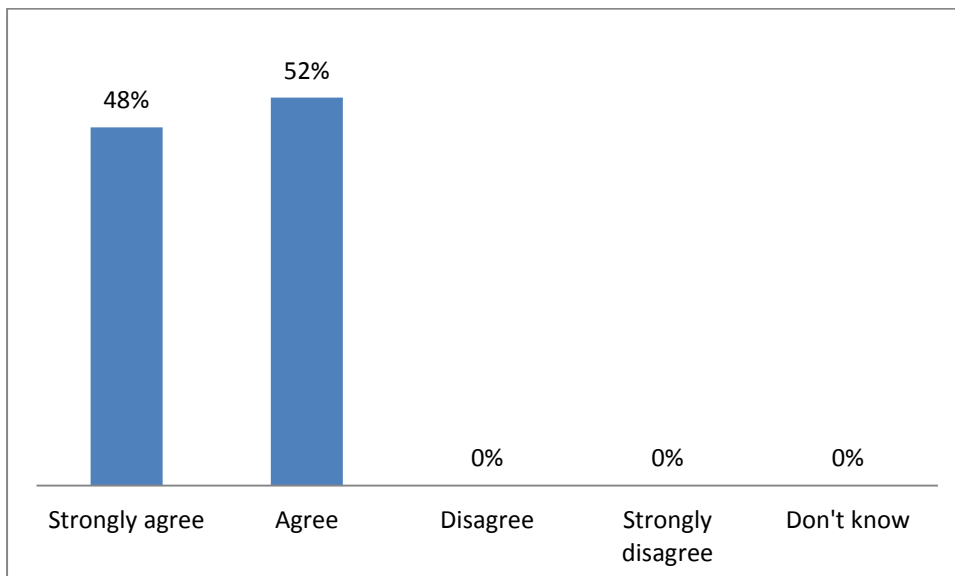
**31 replies received (39%)**

1. My child is happy at Mears Ashby C of E Primary School.

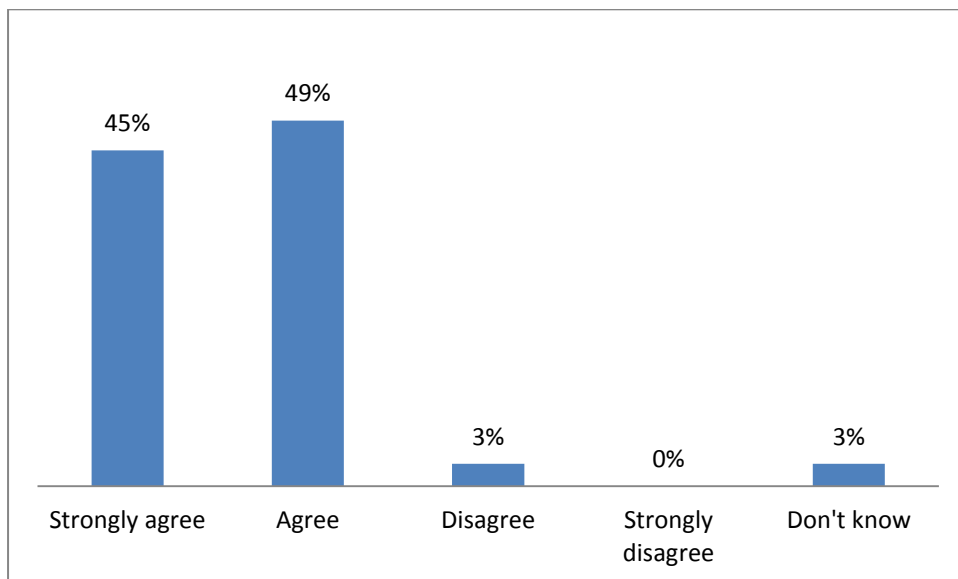


- *'Disagree' gives no explanation as to why but strongly agrees that the child feels safe and well looked after.*

2. My child feels safe at Mears Ashby C of E Primary School.

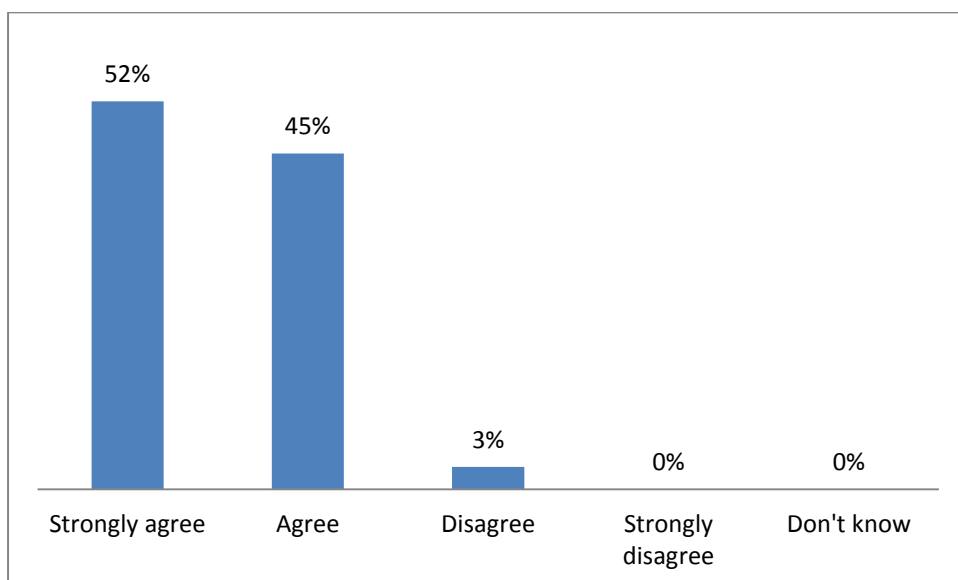


3. My child makes good progress at Mears Ashby C of E Primary School.



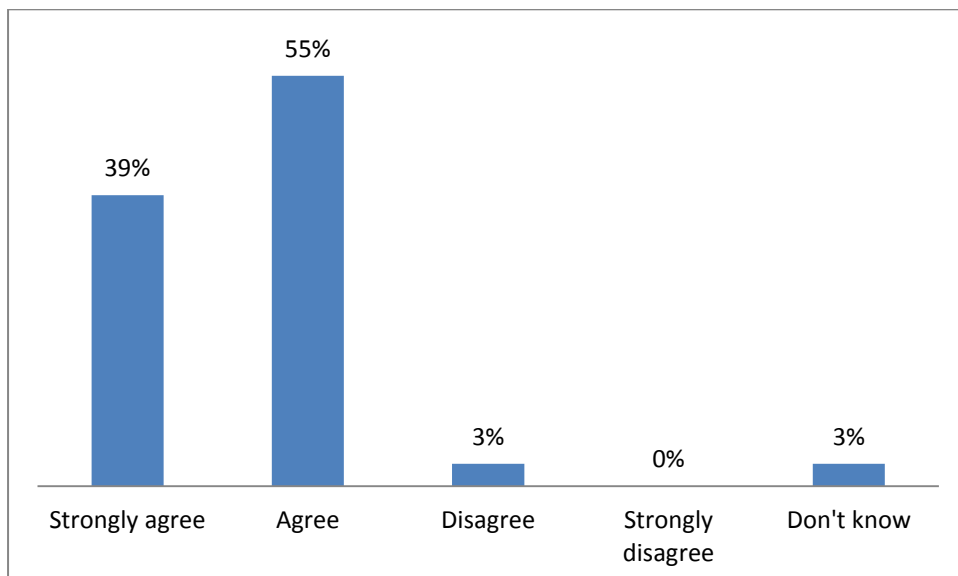
- *'Disagree' cites the reason for this is that the child's 'education about God is poor'.*

4. My child is well looked after at Mears Ashby C of E Primary School.



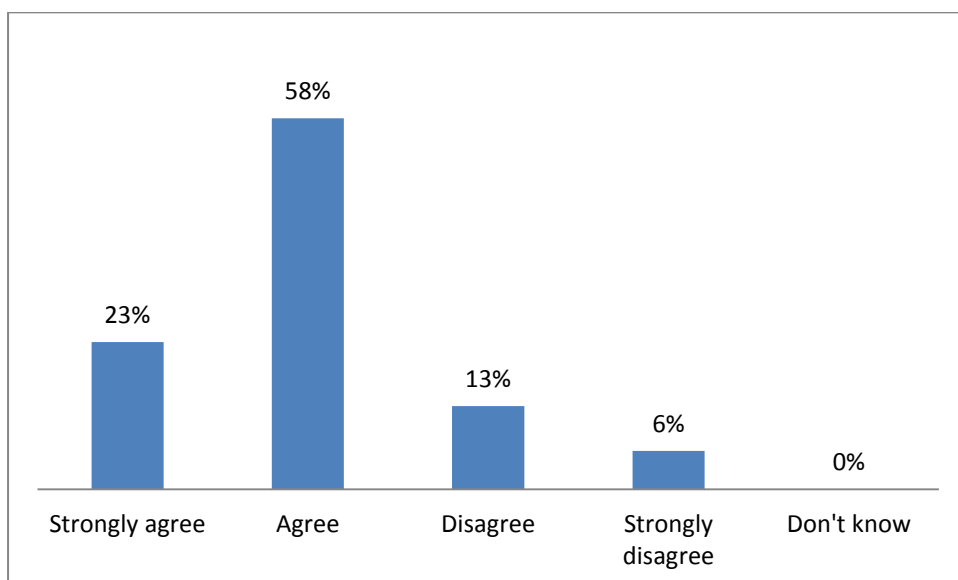
- *'Disagree' gives no explanation.*

5. My child is taught well at Mears Ashby C of E Primary School.



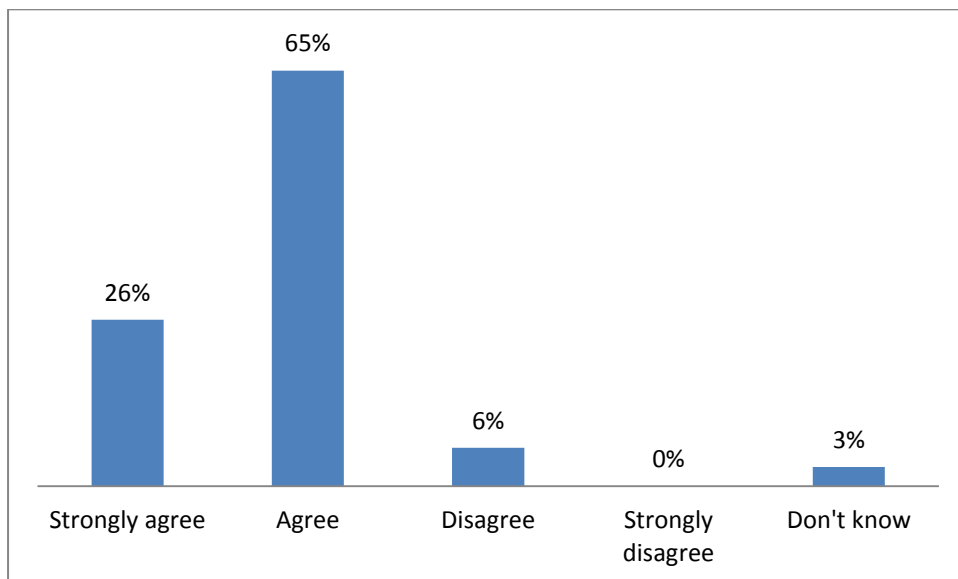
- *'Disagree' cites the reason for this is that the child's 'education about God is poor'.*

6. My child receives appropriate homework for their age.



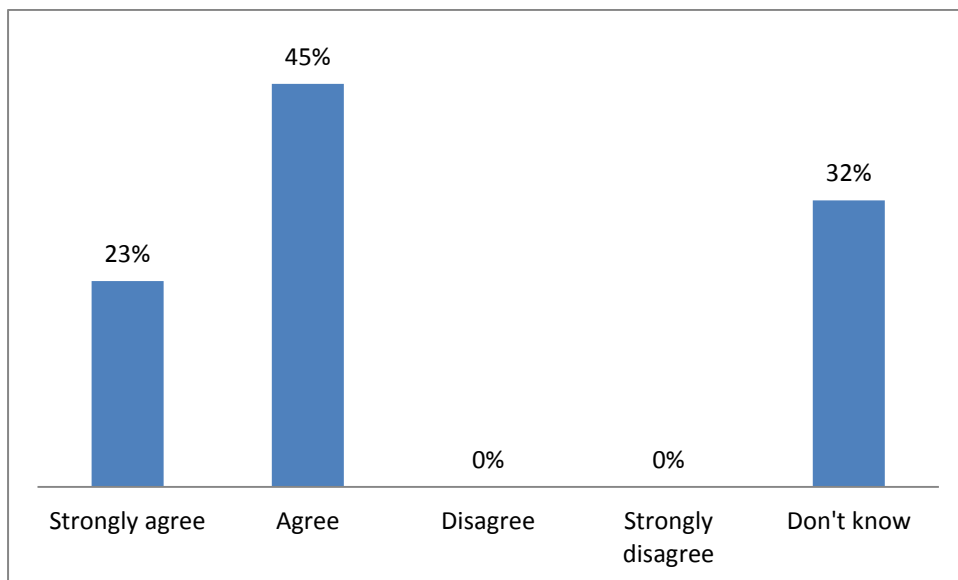
- *'Disagree' and 'Strongly disagree' comment that Key Stage 1 children are given 'too much' homework.*

7. Mears Ashby C of E Primary School makes sure that pupils are well behaved.



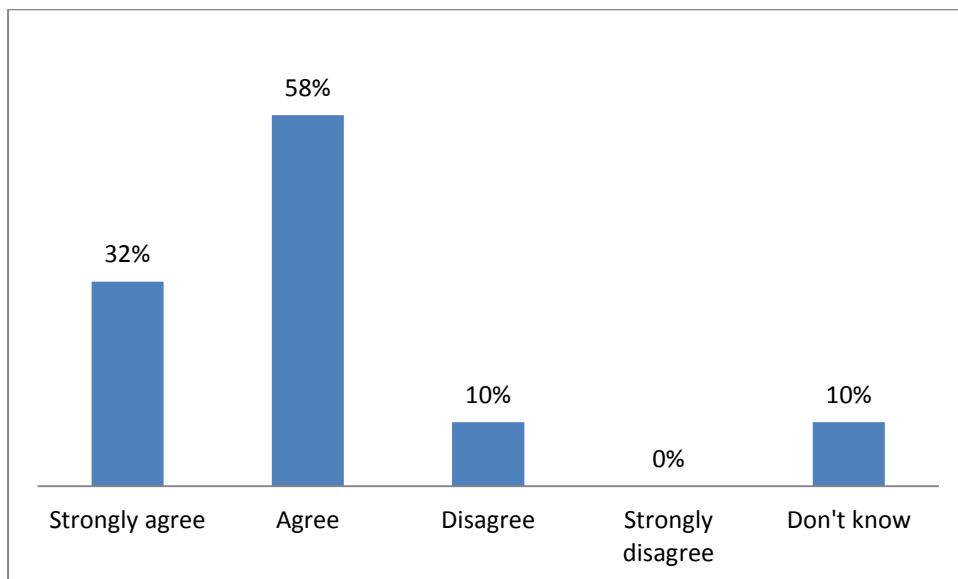
- *'Disagree' and 'Don't know' either agrees or strongly agrees that their child feels happy and safe at school.*

8. Mears Ashby C of E Primary School deals effectively with bullying.



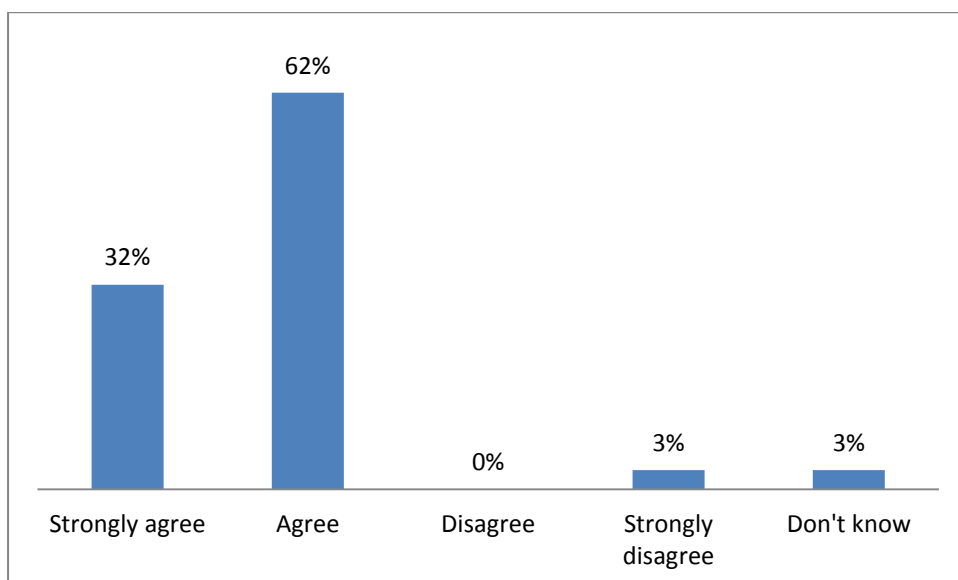
- *'Don't know' comment that their children haven't encountered bullying at school.*

9. Mears Ashby C of E Primary School is well led and managed.



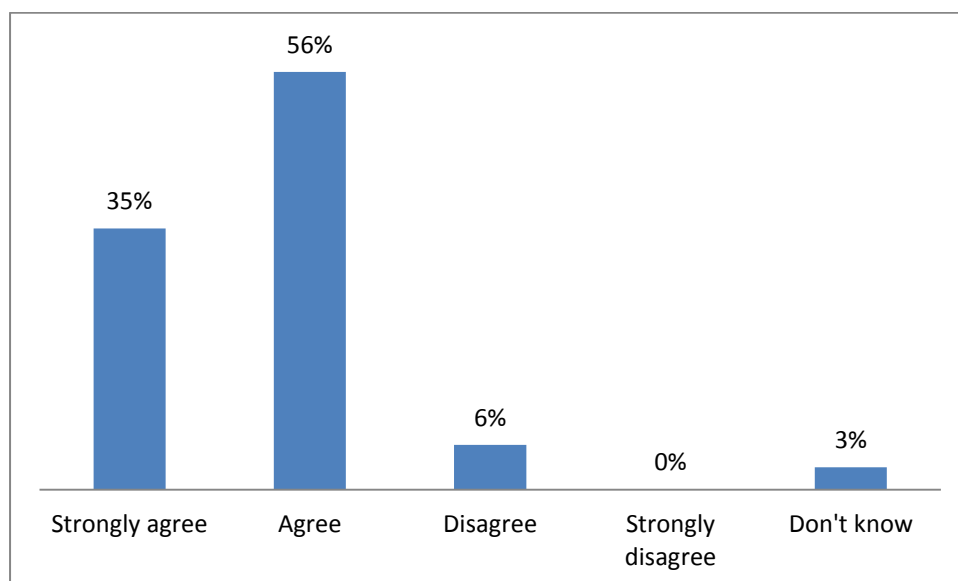
- *'Disagree' make comments about the school losing a 'community feel' due to parents being 'allowed in the school less' during lesson times and during the school day.*

10. Mears Ashby C of E Primary School responds well to any concerns that I have.



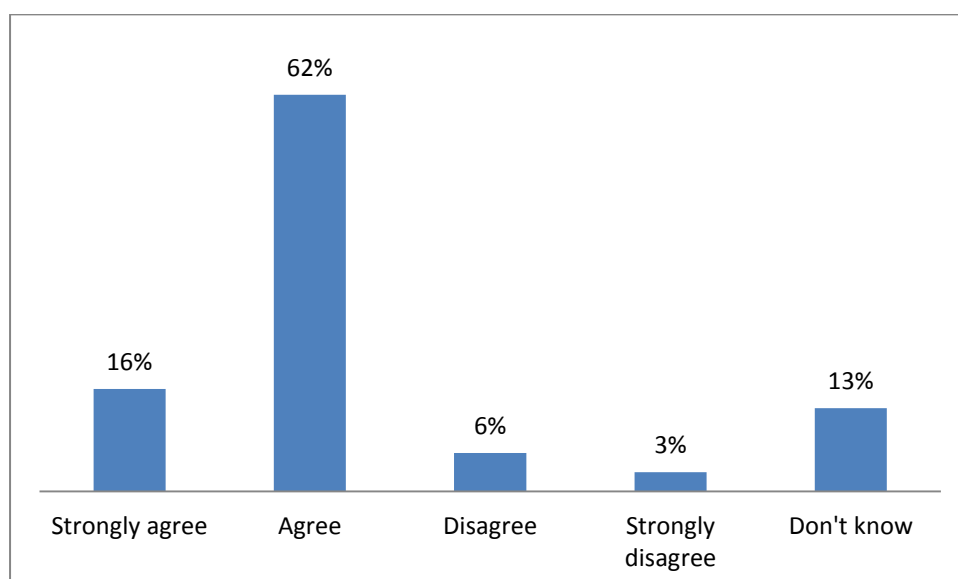
- *'Strongly disagree' and 'Don't know' agree that their child is happy, safe, makes good progress, is taught well at school, and that the school deals effectively with bullying.*

11. I receive valuable information from Mears Ashby C of E Primary School about my child's progress.



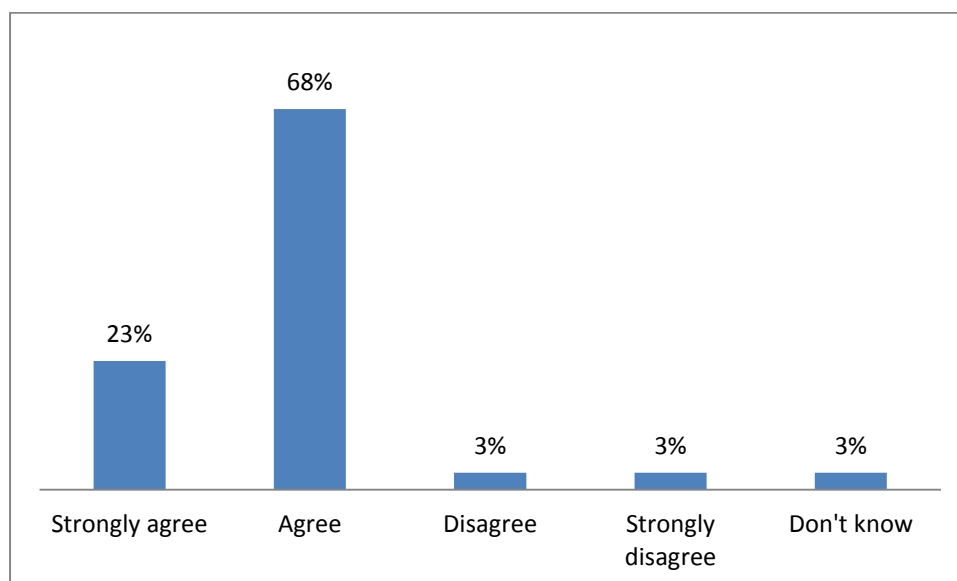
- *'Disagree' agree that their child makes good progress at school.*

12. My child receives good spiritual and religious guidance at Mears Ashby C of E Primary School.



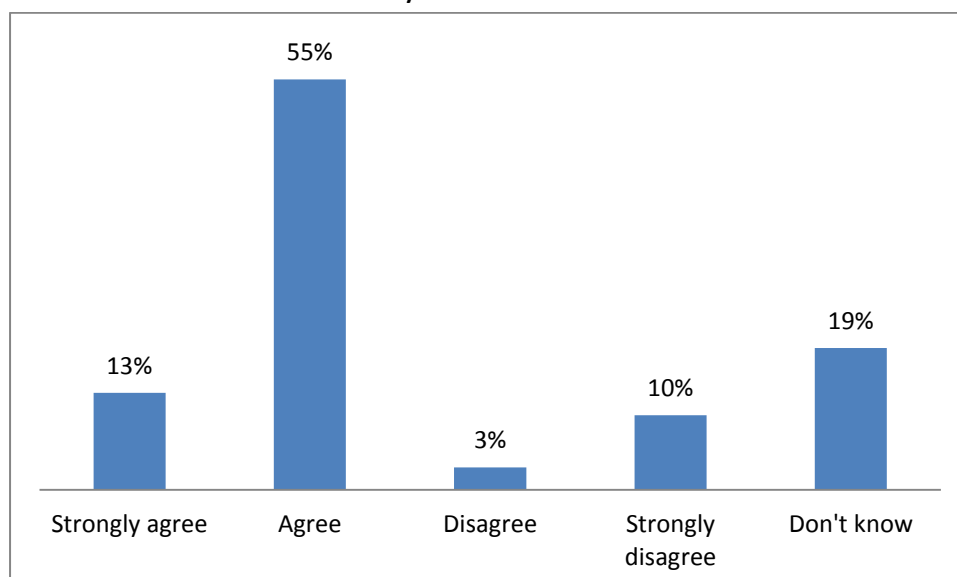
- *'Disagree' and 'Don't know' agree that the church ethos of the school actively supports their child.*
