



**Pupil Deprivation and Education Improvement grant 2016/17**

The school has received a total Grant of £ 202,098.00 for the academic year 2016/17 and intends to undertake the following activities in order to support pupils facing challenges of Poverty and deprivation as follows:

- Provision of discreet Literacy and Numeracy Learning support groups to targeted pupils to support improvement in overall attainment
- Development of Numeracy and Literacy skills throughout the school.
- Refine use of specialised Literacy programmes for use in interventions.
- Maintaining the schools Wellbeing provision to support pupils
- Maintaining the In/Ex provision that supports pupils on a one-to-one and small group basis in order to secure attainment
- Provision of Youth workers to provide intensive support to vulnerable pupils to ensure engagement in school life (April to August 2016)
- Provision of Achieve Program to support attainment at Level 2
- Provision of Learning Mentors to provide target support to pupils to support pupil attainment (April to August 2016)
- Development of pupil tracking and monitoring processes to ensure all pupils reach their potential
- Development of attendance monitoring processes to secure improved levels of attendance for all pupils.

The Schools Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) and Education Improvement (EIG) Grant are regularly scrutinised by the Governing Body, supported by advice from EAS and monitored by the local authority.
