

Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our Science Topic, year 2 will be visiting Mell Farm on Friday 30th June. We will be learning about the rare breeds of cattle and the conservation work that has been undertaken. We will also be learning more about food chains and minibeasts.

We will leave school straight after registration and have our lunch at the farm. A free packed lunch can be ordered in advance, state your child's roll filling choice on the reply slip. Alternatively, you can provide their lunch in a strong disposable plastic carrier bag which can be thrown away once lunch has been eaten. No sweets or fizzy drinks. Every child will need to bring a full water bottle.

The ground may well be muddy so all children will need to wear trainers or wellies (remember, footwear will need to be comfortable as we will be doing a lot of walking.) Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather, ideally in old clothing including long trousers and a waterproof jacket. In addition, please make sure your child has had sun cream applied before leaving home and a sun hat if the sun looks like it will shine! Asthma inhalers will be taken with us as needed.

In order for this visit to go ahead we will need adults to walk down with us and supervise small groups of children whilst at the farm. If you can help us, could you please indicate on the slip below. Thanking you in anticipation.
