This week we achieved above our target again with 97.1%

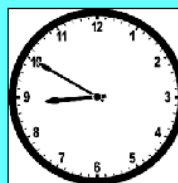

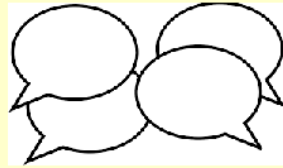

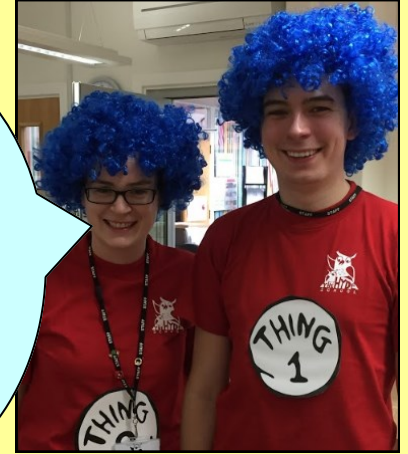
