

End of Key Stage 1 - July 2016

Children at the end of Year 2 (aged 6-7) take part in national standardised tests known as the end of Key Stage 1 SATs. Children at this stage of school are expected to be working at the expected standard for Year 2 in Reading, Writing, Maths and Science. Some children who are more able and working beyond the Year 2 expectations will be identified as Working At Greater Depth.
