Uniform and Appearance Policy

The school uniform is designed to be smart, comfortable, economical and practical. The uniform adds to the ethos of our school and it is a means by which pupils clearly identify with the school. Our uniform and appearance policy was agreed as the result of full consultation with parents, pupils and Governors.

Pupils are expected to adhere to the policy in full at all times.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

KS3: YEARS 7 -9.

BOYS

1. White short sleeved polo shirt with school emblem.
2. Navy crew necked sweatshirt.
3. Formal black trousers.
4. Plain black **SHOES**.
5. Plain dark coloured coat.

Boys PE Kit

1. Pale Blue T Shirt with school emblem.
OR Pale Blue Polo Shirt with school emblem.
2. Black PE shorts.
3. Dark coloured swimming trunks.
4. Reversible Rugby Top.

GIRLS

1. White short sleeved polo shirt with school emblem.
2. Navy crew necked sweatshirt with school emblem.
3. Black skirt (knee length)
OR formal tailored black trousers.
4. Black, navy or flesh coloured tights.
OR white/navy socks (below knee length).
5. Plain black **SHOES** of safe height (sole and heel).
6. Plain dark coloured topcoat.

Girls PE Kit

1. Pale Blue T Shirt with school emblem
OR Pale Blue Polo Shirt with school emblem.
2. Navy wrap or P.E. Skirt or Skort.
3. Dark coloured Swimming Costume.
4. Reversible Rugby Top.

KS4: YEARS 10 -11.

BOYS

1. White shirt with school tie (KS4).
2. Navy V neck jumper with school emblem.
3. Formal black trousers.
4. Plain black **SHOES**.
5. Plain dark coloured coat.

Boys PE Kit

1. Pale Blue T Shirt with school emblem.
OR Pale Blue Polo Shirt with school emblem.
2. Black PE shorts.
3. Dark coloured swimming trunks.
4. Reversible Rugby Top.

GIRLS

1. White shirt with school tie (KS4).
2. Navy V neck jumper with school emblem.
3. Black skirt (knee length)
OR formal tailored black trousers.
4. Black, navy or flesh coloured tights.
OR white/navy socks (below knee length).
5. Plain black **SHOES** of safe height (sole and heel).
6. Plain dark coloured topcoat.

Girls PE Kit

1. Pale Blue T Shirt with school emblem
OR Pale Blue Polo Shirt with school emblem.
2. Navy wrap or P.E. Skirt or Skort.
3. Dark coloured Swimming Costume.
4. Reversible Rugby Top.

SCHOOL UNIFORM - Sixth Form: Years 12 – 13.

BOYS

1. White shirt with school tie (KS5).
2. Black V neck jumper with school emblem.
3. Formal black trousers.
4. Plain black **SHOES**.
5. Plain dark coloured coat.

GIRLS

1. White shirt with school tie (KS5).
2. Black V neck jumper with school emblem.
3. Black skirt (knee length)
OR formal tailored black trousers.
4. Black, navy or flesh coloured tights.
OR white/navy socks (below knee length).
5. Plain black **SHOES** of safe height (sole and heel).
6. Plain dark coloured topcoat.

APPEARANCE CODE

In the interests of Health and Safety, pupils must also meet the following requirements.

They may wear:

1. One **small stud earring** in the lower lobe of each ear. (These must be removed or taped for PE). Facial piercing of any kind is **not** permitted.
2. A watch.
3. One small signet ring (a ring that is flat to the finger).
4. A talisman bracelet or necklace (this indicates health problems/medical problems a pupil may have). This is to be agreed with the relevant Head of Year.

All excessive jewellery will be taken from pupils and kept in the school safe. Parents will be expected to make arrangements with the Head teacher to collect these items.

In order to promote a smart appearance pupils are not allowed to wear:-

1. Alternative items to those described in the uniform list.
2. Hats or caps.
3. Any other form of jewellery (even to protect existing or new piercing).
4. Make-up and nail varnish.
5. Abnormal hair colours, e.g. green/purple/red/pink.
6. Extreme hair styles deemed inappropriate by the school e.g. Mohican, patterns cut into the hair.

Hair accessories (slides, bands, ties) may be worn to hold hair in a safe position or style. These should be of a subdued colour to blend with the uniform.

Hair beads and other decorative hair accessories are not allowed.

Any deviation from the School Policy on uniform/appearance, (e.g. for religious/medical grounds) must be agreed with the relevant member of staff in the pastoral support team e.g. Head of Year

Pupils who do not comply with these requirements will be in breach of School Rules and subject to normal disciplinary procedures.
