



## 2017 TOLLESBURY SCHOOL SUMMER FAIR

Our annual Summer Fair will take place on Friday June 23rd between 3.30pm and 6pm on the school playing field. We have lots of exciting stalls planned but need your help.

We will be having a non-uniform day on 20<sup>th</sup> June and ask that on that day you bring in something from the list below for our Tombola Hampers – you may remember these from our Christmas Fair. The gifts can be given to either Hazel in the office or Class Teachers.

### **EYFS – The Chef hamper**

Suggested items: Spoon rest, marinades, cooking oils, egg timer, oven gloves, cook book, book stand, apron, hand soap, measuring spoons, chopping board, potato peeler, wooden spoon, pastry brush, garlic press.

### **OR Gift wrapping hamper**

Suggested items: wrapping paper, Tissue paper in selection of colours, selection of ribbons, sellotape, scissors, pattern hole punch, glue stick, white glue, name tags, labels, white/silver/gold pens.

### **Year 1 - Ice cream hamper**

Suggested items: Ice cream cones, fruit sauce, chocolate sauce, chocolate chips, sprinkles, marshmallows, chopped nuts, dried fruit, banana chips, waffles.

### **OR Beach hamper**

Suggested items: Beach towels, beach toys, balls, sunblock, sunglasses, outdoor toys (Frisbee, plastic bowling pins), bubbles, chalk.

### **Year 2 - Breakfast hamper**

Suggested items: Tea, coffee, jam, marmalade, tea strainer, marmite, egg cup, tea cosy, egg cosy, cereal, muesli, biscuits, toast cutter, toast rack.

### **OR Coffee lover hamper**

Suggested items: Ground Coffee (different strengths), Espresso, Biscotti, Chocolate Rolled Wafers, Chocolates, Creamer, Flavoured Coffee Syrup, Coffee Mug, Travel Mug, biscuits, small cafetiere.

### **Year 3 - Stationery hamper**

Suggested items: Post-its, paper clips, tape, scissors, glue stick, ruler, eraser, note pad, note book, pen, marker pen, stamps, envelopes, cards, pencil, pencil sharpener, stapler.

### **OR Family game night hamper**

Suggested items: Pack of cards, board games, savoury snacks, crisps, chocolates, adult drinks, kids drinks, olives.

### **Year 4 - Bar-B-Q hamper**

Suggested items: Bar-B-Q utensils, marinades, herbs and spices, apron, mitts, charcoal, Bar-B-Q cookbook, skewers, marshmallows, napkins, corn-on-the-cob holders

### **OR Spa hamper**

Suggested items: Bubble bath, bath salts, candles, magazine, chocolate, bottle of bubbly, nail clippers, nail varnish.

### **Year 5 - Outdoor Adventure**

Suggested items: fishing rod, mini lanterns, skewers, marshmallows, and chocolate, head lamps, bug spray, citronella candles, string, plasters.

### **OR Movie night hamper**

Suggested items: Boxes of sweets and microwave popcorn, savoury snacks, crisps and dips, DVDs, cinema vouchers, fizzy drinks, adult drinks, chocolates.

### **Year 6 Tea lover hamper**

Suggested items: Tea bags, loose tea (black, green, white), herbal teas, teapot for one, tea cup, tea strainer, shortbread, book on tea.

### **OR Crafty hamper**

Suggested items: Markers, pens, coloured pencils, crayons, craft paint, card or paper, paint brushes, stamping kit, jewellery kits, small wooden model kits, beads, poster board, modelling clay, play doh, feathers, stickers.

### **Gifts of alcohol would also be fantastic and these can be left with Hazel in the office**

On **Friday June 23rd** we would be grateful to receive any cakes (home made or not) for our refreshments stall, these can be brought in at school drop off or before 1pm. Please name any tins so they can be returned to you.
