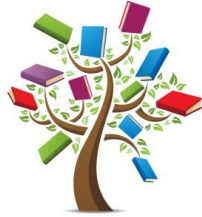


# Welcome to Year One!

Our topic is called 'Toys' we will be learning about different toys through the ages. We have lots of fantastic things to look forward to including toy collages, toy making and lots of exciting map work.



## Literacy

The children will have a great time taking part in our fantastic phonics program where they will be reading each day, using Fred Fingers, Learning set 2 and 3 sounds and writing some super sentences. They will enjoy sharing ideas using 'Talk Partners' and drama.

It is very important for children of this age to be reading to an adult at home on a daily basis – and I would appreciate your support in this. Please also encourage your child to talk about what they have read, and discuss the characters and the settings.

## Maths

The children will be working with numbers up to 50: learning to read, write, count, add and subtract. They will be learning about money, measuring, 2D and 3D shapes.



## Science: Animals, including humans

The children will name human body parts and senses, comparing them with those of common animals. They will get the chance to draw

pictograms using data about differences between children, e.g. hair colour, and discuss the needs of pets.



## Geography: Toys

This term the children will get the chance to talk about their wonderful holidays, investigate and locate places on a map and explore where various toys come from.



## History: Toys

The children will have great fun exploring and comparing old and new toys, objects and traditions relating to Christmas.



## ICT: We are treasure hunters and we are TV chefs!

This term the children will learn to control and program a programmable toy by inputting a sequence of instructions to find the buried treasure. They will also develop and record sequences of instructions as an algorithm. After half term the children will have a great time producing short videos of themselves making a healthy snack.

## RE: People in Christianity

The children will be talking and thinking about being inspired and will be encouraged to listen to the views and ideas of others. They will listen to a variety of religious stories and retell them in different ways, using drama, hot seating and art.

## Design and Technology: Toys

The children will design and build a Toy for our Toy shop.

## Art: Toys

The children will have great fun mixing colours to produce a toy painting. They will be cutting, folding and sticking to produce a toy collage and create their own version of a toy.



## Music: Exploring sounds and duration and singing with control

The children will recognise how to make sounds louder, quieter, faster and slower. They will also learn how to make and control short and long sounds.

The children will learn a variety of songs including traditional Christmas carols and accompany using instruments.



## P.E.

In Physical Education the children will be taking part in a selection of games and athletic activities. They will use a wide range of equipment to develop their balance, stamina and coordination in fun and exciting ways.

## PSHE (Personal, Social, Health Education):

The children will be learning about new beginnings: creating an understanding of empathy, self-awareness, social skills and motivation.
