Maths: 5 lessons each week – covering the Lancashire objectives. Mental arithmetic will be a weekly focus and the year 6 children will be working towards their SATs May 8th. After SATS we will continue to use and apply our mathematical skills. Maths booster groups will continue and your child may be given extra sessions/ homework throughout the term.

English: 5 lessons each week – including SPAG, reading comprehension and Big Writes. Our class reader will be The Jungle Book and we will be studying poetry – William Blake. Non fiction writing and explanation texts will be also feature, linked to the Rainforest topic.

French:

Seasons, weather and animals will be covered. We will also link to the DT topic with food tasting and making.

Science:

- Living things and habitats.
- Animals, including humans.

Geography:

This will be our main focus of the term – learning all about the rainforest. This will include studying Rainforest countries, climate zones, deforestation, vegetation and eco systems. Our main focus will be Brazil / The Amazon.
