Glossary of terms

ARE - Age Related Expectation – expected standard at the end of Year 2/6.

Progress Score - data and results from the end of KS1 are compared to data and results from the end of KS2 in order to produce a progress score.

Average Scaled Score - test scores are standardised and converted into 'Scaled Scores'. The expected standard is recognised as 100 or above.

High Level of Attainment - a higher level of attainment is defined as a scaled score of 110 or above.
