<p><u>Our Topic this term will be Fairytales;</u> <u>we will be:</u> Following recipes to make porridge. Looking at the materials used to build homes. Investigating waterproof materials so we can help fix the 3 little pig's house. Finding out about boats and bridges to help the 3 Billy Goats Gruff cross the river. Designing a menu for Cinderella's ball. Helping to save a witch from a dragon's cave.</p> <p><u>We will be reading</u> Goldilocks and the 3 Bears. The 3 Little Pigs. The 3 Billy Goats Gruff. Cinderella Room on a Broom.</p>	<p><u>Things to do at home.</u> Visit the library and look for Fairy Tales and information books. Look at the different materials used at home and in the local area. Share Fairy Tales. Use puppets or props to retell familiar stories (Children will be making and bringing home some simple puppets).</p>
<p><u>English</u> Our English work this term will focus on: Reading simple sentences in fiction and non fiction books. Sequencing and retelling familiar stories. Using phonic skills to read and write a growing range of words. Writing simple sentences and experimenting with writing for a variety of reasons including, lists, instructions and invitations.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Our number work this term will focus on: Reinforcing number recognition and counting amounts to 20 and beyond. Adding and taking away single digit numbers using objects and number lines. Exploring doubling and halving small numbers. We will be using shapes to create models and pictures and will sort, match and name a range of 2D and 3D shapes.</p> 
<p>Soon the weather will be getting warmer so please remember to send your child with a hat and wearing sun cream.</p> 	<p><u>Homework.</u> A phonic activity will be sent home each Friday and should be returned the following Thursday. Reading books should be brought to school each day and will be collected in on a Friday ready for the following week. Please date and sign your child's reading record book when you read at home.</p>
