Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)

The EYPP has been introduced by the Government and will pay early years providers an additional £300 per financial year for each eligible three and four year old child that takes up their full 15 hour entitlement.

A child will be eligible for the EYPP if their parents are in receipt of one or more of the following benefits or credits:

- Income support
- Income-based job seekers allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, but not Working Tax Credit, with an annual gross income of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on- paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

OR the child has:

- Been Looked After by the local authority for at least one day
- Been Adopted from care
- Left care through Special Guardianship
- Been or is subject to a child arrangement order (formerly known as a residence order)*

**A photocopy of the relevant court order or Adoption certificate must be sent to the funding office as supporting evidence.*

When your child starts Nursery you will be given a EYPP form to complete regardless of whether you are eligible or not, so that this information can be passed on to the local authority.
