It has been a very successful year for CBJS as a Children's University School. 241 children received Bronze Award for completing 30 hours of out of school learning. 47 received a Silver Award (for 65 hours) and 17 received the highly coveted Gold Award at the University of Birmingham for an incredible 100 hours of out of school learning. As well as in-school clubs and University sessions, children can also earn hours from over 20 North Solihull Learning Destinations (double the amount that existed in September) as well as hundreds of others in the local area and further afield. We are looking forward to building on this success next year.
