

# **North Ferriby Show 2017**

The competitions have been organised across three age ranges: 5 & under, 7 & under and 11 & under. For each age range there are a number of 'classes' that can be entered. ## **Key Dates:**

**Deadline for the entry forms:** **3pm, Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> July**  
(forms can be handed in either to the school or to the post office)

**Exhibits (entries) delivered to the village hall:** **between 8:30am and 10:30am,**  
**Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> July**

### RULES

#### **Only Two Entries are Allowed in Each Class. No Joint Names**

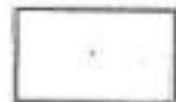
**Late & Additional** entries will only be accepted up to 12 0'clock on **Friday 21 July** by telephone or email to the Show Secretary. No late entries can be accepted on the morning of the show.

Staging of exhibits will be from 8.30am until 10.30am on the morning of the show. **Staging WILL NOT be permitted after this time.** Members of the public must leave the hall by 10.30am **Judging commences at 11am**

#### **Show open to the public at 2pm. Presentation of Trophies at 4pm**

1. That the judges be chosen by the Committee and that their decision is final.
2. That all questions of dispute which do not come within the jurisdiction of the Judges shall be settled by the Show Secretary.
3. That the committee, together with the officers, shall be responsible for the arranging of the classes.
4. **That all exhibits remain on the show bench until after the trophy presentation.**
5. That all exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor and unless stated in the schedule must have been grown, raised, produced, or made by the exhibitor. Except classes 57, 58 & 158, 159 for which purchased flowers and accessories are allowed
6. That any exhibitor has the option of lodging an objection before 3pm to any exhibit.
7. If there is any doubt as to the bono-fides of any exhibit or exhibits the Show Secretary reserves the right to disqualify such entry or entries.
8. Exhibitors to provide their own containers & plates for all classes unless stated in the schedule.
9. Children's prize money may be collected from the Show Office between 3pm & 4pm
10. All precautions will be taken against loss or damage to exhibitors' property. The Committee cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage caused.
11. For public interest exhibitors are requested to name the variety of exhibit whenever possible.
