



Admissions Procedure and Visits

Admissions Procedure:

Pre-school places are available for 2-year-old children who are entitled to free childcare. This is the term after they turn two. Your 2-year-old can get free early education and childcare if you receive one of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Universal Credit
- tax credits and you have an annual income of under £16,190 before tax
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- support through part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act
- the Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

You will need to complete an application form from the school office and produce evidence of your entitlement to free childcare.

Visits:

Open Day-

On Friday 30th June we will be holding an open day. This is a perfect opportunity for you and your child to experience the provision. You can meet and chat to the highly qualified staff, ask any questions you may have. There will be lots of activities for you and your child to do.

Home Visits-

Two members of staff will come to visit your child at their home. This is a valuable opportunity for staff and families to begin getting to know each other in a place where the family, especially the child, feels most comfortable. This will aid transition between home and Sandilands First Steps reinforcing the importance of families in educating their child and enable information to be shared.
