- Behaviours that cause harm to themselves
- Anxiety and/or low mood that significantly impacts daily functioning.

They are a specialist service therefore will expect that universal and targeted services have been accessed

What happens after a referral is made?

The referrals are discussed every week at the referral meeting and a decision is made if further



information is needed, a triage may then take place or it is placed on a waiting list

A letter is sent to Parents/Carers/GP/School Nurses and referrer to inform them of the outcome

What happens if a child / young person is not accepted for treatment following a referral?

A letter is sent to the referrer and advice given regarding where an alternative service may be most appropriate to meet the person's needs.

All Nurses are qualified Registered Nurses Learning Disabilities and Registered with the Nursing and Midwifery Council
