- Explore how to care for chicks

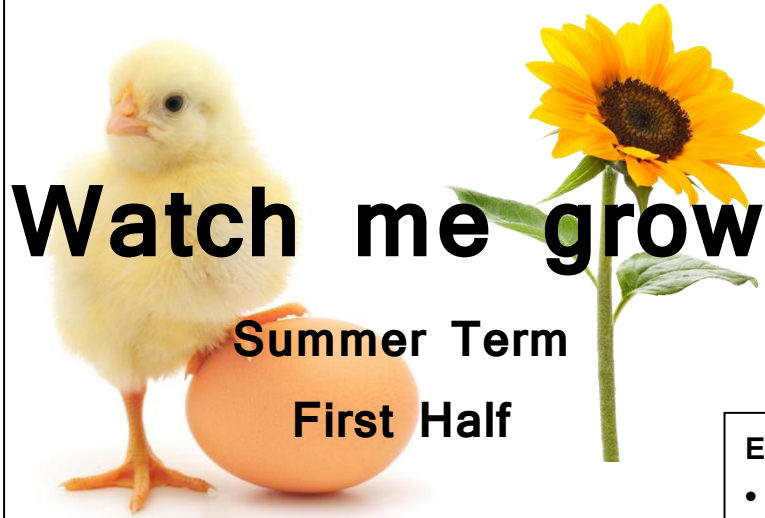
Understanding the World
