The spring topic for Year 1 is geography based. We will investigate the UK and learn about the four main areas within in it. We will locate the UK on a globe and note other land masses, seas and oceans. We will think about maps, compass points, and direction. We will take a walk around our local community thinking about direction, in addition to our next season's walk along the dyke.



Literacy - Year 1 will continue to build upon and secure their knowledge relating to reading and spelling (decoding and blending) becoming more familiar with a wider range of text types, and different genres. We will continue with our spelling and application of different pronunciations and uses of the same graphemes.

Maths - we will continue practising our number bonds to 10, 20 and 30. Being able to count forward and backward from a given start point to 100, using different steps. We will continue with addition and subtraction and thinking about word problems with the focus on the wording used.

PE - we will have an indoor and outdoor session each week.

DT/Art - we aim to cook a seasonal dish as part of our 'seasons' science topic. We will also design and make a model.

Computing - we will start to use Scratch Jr as an ipad app learning to programme a car to travel around a given road way.

RE - we will continue to follow the Come & See syllabus (special people, meals and change).
