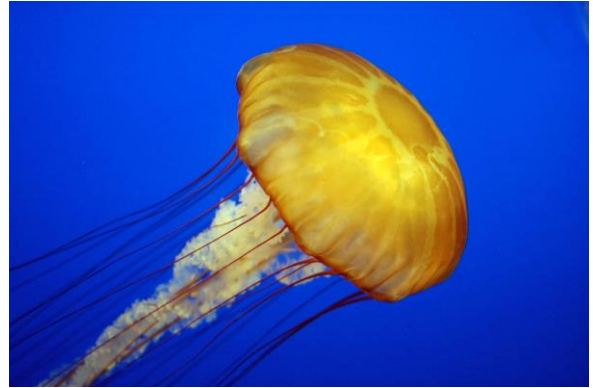


Under the Sea

Autumn 2016

The autumn topic for Year 1 is a science based unit entitled 'Animals, including Humans'. We will explore classification and senses comparing humans with different animal groups. We hope to visit a Beach to track down some invertebrates.



Literacy - we will use a variety of topic based story books. Children will create information texts about species which live under the sea. They will continue to build upon and secure their knowledge relating to reading and spelling (decoding and blending) becoming more familiar with a wider range of text types, and different genres.

Maths - we will have maths chats starting at 8.45am when children can put their maths skills to the test. We will continue learning our number bonds to 10, 20 and 30. Being able to count forward and backward from a given start point to 100, using different steps.

PE - we will have an indoor and outdoor session each week.

DT/Art - we aim to cook some seasonal dishes, and learn to use paint in different ways.

Computing - research using computers and ipads, Internet safety and other forms of programming and controlling electronic equipment (eg. Beebots).

RE - we will continue to follow the Come & See syllabus.
